

Developing Objectives for Continuing Education Programs

Objectives MUST be:

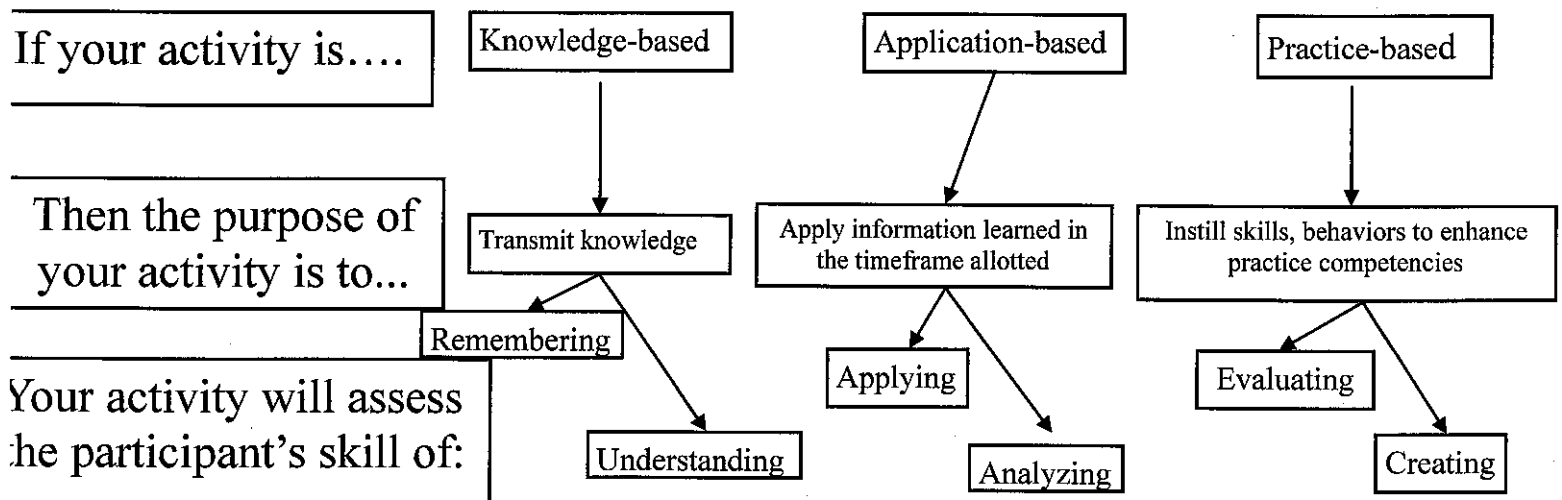
- Specific and measurable
- Developed to specifically address the identified educational need
- Addressed by an active learning activity
- Covered by a learning assessment

A Learning Objective Consists of TWO parts: VERB + STEM

Verb: chosen by activity type that elicits or describes a measurable or observable behavior

Stem: Outcome-based take away

CPE activities progress through a continuum of learning: knowledge < application < practice
